WRIT OF ELECTION

TO THE ELECTION COMMISSIONERS OF ATTALA, CARROLL, CHOCTAW, KEMPER, NESHOBA, AND WINSTON COUNTIES, MISSISSIPPI:

A vacancy exists in the Office of Chancery Judge for the Sixth Chancery District, Place 1 due to the resignation of the Honorable Joseph Kilgore effective July 31, 2024.

Therefore, pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. §§ 9-1-103, 23-15-833 and 23-15-849, and having appointed the Honorable Doug S. Crosby to serve until such vacancy is filled by special election, I, Tate Reeves, Governor of the State of Mississippi, do hereby issue this Writ of Election, and hereby declare that the special election to fill the vacancy in the Office of Chancery Judge for the Sixth Chancery District, Place 1 shall be held on **November 4, 2025**. Pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 23-15-833, this special election shall in all respects be held, conducted and returned in the same manner as general elections, except that where no candidate receives a majority of the votes cast in the special election, a runoff election shall be held four (4) weeks after the special election. Further, this special election shall be held and noticed in accordance with the Nonpartisan Judicial Election Act, Miss. Code Ann. § 23-15-974, *et seq*.

Candidates shall qualify not later than 5:00 p.m. on **February 3, 2025**, pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 23-15-977.

The Election Commissioners of Attala, Carroll, Choctaw, Kemper, Neshoba, and Winston Counties shall give notice of this special election pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 23-15-835.

All other relevant state laws not in conflict with the terms of this Writ of Election shall further apply.

The Election Commissioners of Attala, Carroll, Choctaw, Kemper, Neshoba, and Winston Counties shall govern themselves accordingly.
